Dear Friends of St. Peregrine,

As I continue to pray for all of you these days, I am reflecting on the words of St. Paul... "God comforts us in all our afflictions and thus enables us to comfort those who are in trouble, with the same consolation we have received from God. Jesus heals in many different ways - Megan's Story

Hi Father Chris!

I am Deacon Chris K's daughter, Megan. He emailed you about my family and our journey with my non-Hodgkin's lymphoma. We found out great news... Jesus the Healer has healed me completely!

We saw my oncologist in Philadelphia today, and she reviewed my most recent scans with us. Up until today, all of the doctors I've seen have hesitated to use the word "remission" with my case, and have always referred to it as "partial." They've explained to me that this type of cancer typically doesn't go into remission, and if it does it will most likely come back. Well, there was no hesitation in her voice today when she looked at the results on the screen, looked at us, smiled and said "Absolutely beautiful... everything is clear. You're in continual, complete remission." She went on to explain that even the slightly enlarged lymph nodes that showed up on my scans from

a year ago have completely and totally shrunk. I was confused at how this could be, as I have not had any form of treatment in over a year and a half. She smiled at our little 6 week old baby boy, snuggled in my husband's arms. She explained that during the pregnancy, my body's immune system would have been strengthened, and that could have something to do with the positive results.

So it seems to me that Jesus heals in many different ways, including sending us children, who heal us in so many unknown ways.

We thank God for his mercy, St. Peregrine and all the Saints for their prayers, and you for your ministry!
